- Faculty, staff and students who are authorized to travel must book travel through an approved [Stanford Booking Channel](#).

¹ Factors in assessing health and safety risk include, but are not limited to, [International SOS assessment](#), availability and reliability of testing, vaccination status, potential for community spread, status of health infrastructure, entry restrictions, and feasibility of evacuation.

² [Approval](#) required. Limited exceptions for [essential education or essential research](#), as evaluated by the traveler's school or department, if the traveler is [fully vaccinated](#) in compliance with CDC guidelines.

³ [Approval](#) required. Limited exceptions for [essential education or essential research](#), as evaluated by the traveler's school or department. The [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) and the [California Department of Public Health](#) recommend that domestic travelers be [fully vaccinated](#).

⁴ If a third party books travel, it must be [registered via MyTrips](#) (for example, faculty travel to a conference funded and/or booked by a non-Stanford entity).
