Taking off face covering	 Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth when removing the face covering. When taking off the face coverings, loop your finger into the strap and pull the strap away from the ear, or untie the straps. Wash hands immediately after removing. 	
Care, Storage and Laundering	 Keep face coverings stored in a paper bag when not in use. Launder with regular clothing detergent before first use, and after each shift. Dispose of face-covering if: Visibly damaged (i.e., stretched ear loops, torn or punctured material); or Dirty or visibly contaminated 	 Keep in manufacturer packaging until needing to use it.
